Island Health required that the Town revise the gency Reponse Plan to state that a Boil Water Notice is to be issued the furbidit. Several ceeds 1 NTU at point of disinfection.

1.0 NTU turbidity has been to de suideline value because turbidity above this level has been linked to an increase probility of adverse health effects.

The Town of Lake Conchan's source water is an unprotected body of water and at this time there is not a Water here to tection Plan. Because a specific source of the turbidity cannot be specified, we use unable to determine whether the make-up is organic or inorganic material. At this time, we cannot be sure that harmful pathogens are not present at levels that exceed the capacity of the chlorination to properly treat the water. Due to these reasons, Island Health is considering this an elevated risk event which requires the issuance of a Boil Water Notice."
