# FISHERY NOTICE

## Restrictions to fishing in the Cowichan River

A reminder to all Recreational Fishers, as per the 2013 – 2015 Freshwater Fishing Regulations Synopsis (page 16):


Effective August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014 until midnight November 15, 2014 the Cowichan River is CLOSED to all angling from the CNR Trestle (Mile 66) downstream to the Tidal Boundary.

Also Effective August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014 until midnight November 15, 2014 the Cowichan River is FLY-FISHING ONLY from the Weir at Cowichan Lake downstream to the CNR Trestle (Mile 66).

Also so a reminder that the Cowichan River is CLOSED TO THE RETENTION OF ALL CHINOOK SALMON. This is a year round restriction.
