The Town of Lake Cowichan Council is no exception. Staff has presented Council in a previous meeting some of the Capital budget suggestions for Council to consider for 2021. We hope to finish up in February discussing the remainder of the capital items. After that we will meet to analyze the effect of the operational and capital costs contained in the draft budget.
