- Resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed (March 8, 2022 or earlier); and
- Not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia, or from being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.
