

Town of Lake Cowichan Property Tax Newsletter



Tax payments must be received at the Town Office by 4:30 p.m. on July 4, 2017. Online payments require more processing time. Pay early to avoid a 10% penalty.

If you are eligible for the Homeowner Grant, the completed grant application (the bottom portion of your tax notice) must be submitted to the Town Office by the due date. If a mortgage company pays your taxes, you are still responsible for completing the homeowner grant application, if eligible.



Payment options:

1. Mail your cheque and/or homeowner grant application to the Town Office. Ensure your payment is received before 4:30 p.m. on July 4, 2017. The post-mark date is not accepted as proof of payment date.
2. Pay your tax or utility payments through telephone or online banking. Pay early (generally three to eight business days) to allow for bank processing times.
TIP: Problems with online payment: add one or two zeros in front of your roll number.
3. Tax and utility payments can be made by cash, debit or cheque at the Town Office. We do accept post-dated cheques made payable for the due date.

The annual renewal notices for tax deferment will be mailed out by May 31st. The Province will *only* accept the preprinted forms this year. If you do not receive your renewal application form please request another form from the Province.

Watering restrictions are in effect for Lake Cowichan. For more information refer to the Town's website under Public Works and Engineering Services.

- Watering times are: 7:00-9:00am or 7:00-9:00pm.
- Weeper hoses are included as micro irrigation for watering trees, shrubs and gardens. Soaker hoses are not considered micro-irrigation.
- Washing of houses is not permitted under Stage 2 restrictions.
