



TOWN OF LAKE COWICHAN

ADVANCE ELECTORAL REGISTRATION

Advance electoral registrations will be accepted at the Town of Lake Cowichan Town Office, temporarily located in the former Island Savings Credit Union building at 38 King George Street North, Lake Cowichan, BC until August 23rd, 2022. Elector registrations will not be accepted after this date except on voting days.

ELECTORAL QUALIFICATIONS

A RESIDENT ELECTOR must be:

- ◆ age 18 or older; and
- ◆ a Canadian Citizen; and
- ◆ a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration; and
- ◆ a resident of the Town of Lake Cowichan for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration; and
- ◆ not be disqualified by any enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

A NON-RESIDENT ELECTOR must be:

- ◆ age 18 or older; and
- ◆ a Canadian Citizen; and
- ◆ a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration; and
- ◆ a registered owner of real property in the Town of Lake Cowichan for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration; and
- ◆ not entitled to register as a resident elector; and
- ◆ not be disqualified by any enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law; and
- ◆ **if there is more than one registered owner of the property, only one of those individuals may, with the written consent of the majority of the owners, register as a non-resident property elector.**

LIST OF REGISTERED ELECTORS

Beginning August 30th, 2022 until the close of general voting for the election on October 15th, 2022, a copy of the list of electors will be available for public inspection at the Town Office, temporarily located in the former Island Savings Credit Union building at 38 King George Street North in Lake Cowichan during regular office hours (8:30 am to 4:30 pm), Monday to Friday, excluding statutory holidays. Before inspecting the list, a person must sign a statement that they will not inspect the list or use the information included in the list except for the purposes of Part 3 - Electors and Elections of the *Local Government Act*. An elector may request that their address or other information about them be omitted from or obscured on the list of electors.

OBJECTION TO REGISTRATION OF AN ELECTOR

An objection to the registration of a person whose name appears on the list of registered electors may be made in accordance with the *Local Government Act* until 4:00 pm on September 9th, 2022. An objection must be in writing and may only be made by a person entitled to be registered as an elector of the Town of Lake Cowichan and can only be made on the basis that the person whose name appears has died or is not qualified to be registered as an elector of the Town of Lake Cowichan.
